Program Description:

This course is designed for dental professionals interested in advancing their knowledge and skills in comprehensive full arch implant rehabilitation using the FP1 and ALL on X technique. Participants will learn the principles of treatment planning, overview of the surgical techniques to help their specialists with proposed outcomes, prosthetic design, and seamless integration of conventional and digital workflows to achieve optimal clinical outcomes.

Program Objectives:

At the completion of the program, participants should be able to:

- Understand the principles of full arch implant rehabilitation and the advantages of the FP1 and ALL on X technique.
- Explore the treatment planning process, including case selection, diagnostics, and interdisciplinary coordination.
- Overview of the surgical techniques involved in full arch implant placement, including flapless surgery and immediate loading protocols so that the restorative dentists can review with their patients what to expect and kind of sequence is involved.
- Learn about prosthetic design considerations for full arch restorations, including material selection, occlusal schemes, and esthetics.
- Implement a seamless integration of conventional and digital workflows, including 3D imaging, CAD/CAM technologies, and guided surgery protocols.
- Discuss post-operative care, maintenance protocols, and long-term success factors for full arch implant restorations.



Shankar Iyer

Dr. Iyer graduated with honors from the New York University College of Dentistry and went on to pursue graduate studies in Prosthodontics from the same University. He taught as a clinical Assistant Professor for several years at NYU's department of Post Graduate Prosthodontics. Currently he holds two appointments in the departments of Periodontics and Prosthodontics at Rutgers' University Dental School, New Jersey. Dr. Iyer is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Implantology/Implant Dentistry and a Fellow of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry. He is the Director of the prestigious AAID Implant Maxicourse held in Asia with centers in Abu Dhabi and Bangalore. He co-directs these courses at Rutgers University, New Jersey. Nova Southeastern University, Florida, Roseman University, Utah and Newport Beach, California. Dr. Iyer was inducted as a Fellow in the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons, Glasgow and has Fellowships in reputed organizations such as the Greater New York Academy of Prosthodontists, and the Dental Facial Esthetics Academy. He is the Past President of the American Academy of Implant Dentistry and regularly participates in volunteering for the Annual Meetings of the Academy as a Scientific Chair. Dr. Iyer has lectured in 34 countries and has presented in over 150 Symposia in Implant Dentistry and Prosthodontics.
